Tree of Me

How are we similar to trees? What do we need in order to thrive?

Symbolically, roots and branches can represent the following:

ROOTS: Roots can represent what has helped you become who you are today. This can include your environment (your home, upbringing, etc), people in your life (family, friends, mentors), certain events or experiences in your life, your personality traits, your culture, faith etc.

BRANCHES: Branches and leaves can represent your future goals and steps you need to reach your goals. Where do you see yourself in the near future? What are your hopes, goals and dreams? What steps may you need to take to get there? Start sketching your ideas in your notebook/sketchbook. You should use words as well as pictures.

Knowledge and Understanding

- ★ 2 or more mediums (pencil, pen, pencil crayon, paint, collage, etc)
- ★ Roots depict all 4 requirements: environment/people, experiences, culture/faith, values/traits
- ★ Branches represent all 3 requirements: new art skills learned, personal growth, goals for the future

Application

- Elements and principles of design are applied effectively and creatively
- Use of medium shows the mastery of techniques
- Overall work is visually appealing
- Symbolism is accurately representative of ideas
